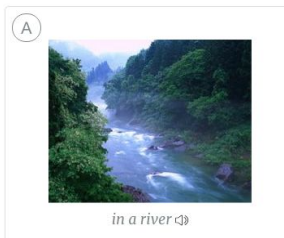


A Guide to the ReadWorks Question Set (Kindergarten)

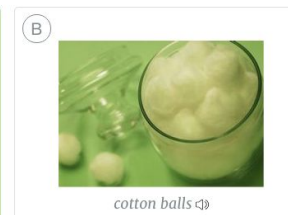
Clouds and Rain by ReadWorks

1. Where can you see clouds?



2. What are clouds made of?



3. What can gray clouds bring?



4. Why do raindrops fall from the sky?



1-4 Explicit Information

The first four questions ask about important information in the text. You should be able to point to the answers right in the text!

5. What can clouds look like?

5. Explicit Information

This question asks about information that is important to the big idea of the text. A lot of times this question will get you thinking about information that will help you answer the drawing question coming up!

6. What did you learn from "Clouds and Rain"?

6. Explicit or Inferential

This question asks you to share what you learned from the text.

7. Draw a picture of clouds in the sky.

7. Explicit or Inferential

This question asks you about information that is important to the big idea of the text. You can draw your answer to this question!
